6-Month Remote Certificate Course:

This new offering is a 6-month remote course supporting multiple disciplines of professionals globally in the integration of current theories of development and change processes, supported by small reflective practice groups.

Participants will receive a Certificate in Early Relational Health: Upon completion of 60 hours of training, in 30 hours of didactic and interactive learning sessions and 30 hours of reflective consultation groups supporting participants' integration of theory to practice.
